Horizon Air is required to qualify all vendors performing maintenance activities on company operated aircraft components in order to satisfy the requirements of 14 CFR 121.373. Horizon Air Engineering Orders/Build Specifications, Component Maintenance Manuals, Manufacturing design data, and other FAA accepted or approved data.
