As an Approved Maintenance Provider for Southwest Airlines (SWA), this letter is being sent to notify you of SWA's receipt and review of the contract maintenance listing, dated **6/24/2014, Rev B**, and that SWA has determined that the attached contract maintenance listing is considered as an Approved Subcontractor Listing for the performance of maintenance, preventive maintenance, and alterations on SWA components or parts with the exception of the following:

For SWA approved subcontractors, the following must be adhered to:

1. Your oversight of subcontractors must meet the standards established in the SWA Outsource Maintenance Providers Manual (OPSM). Refer to [OPSM 02-07 Subcontracted Work](#).
2. Deviations to work instructions or work specifications must be authorized by SWA. Refer to [OPSM 03-19 Deviations](#).

When the need arises to use a subcontractor not listed on the Approved Subcontractor Listing you must complete one of the following prior to use:

1. Submit a revised contract maintenance listing and/or a detailed listing of those intended to be used for performance of maintenance on SWA components or parts for review and approval; or
2. Submit a Subcontracted Maintenance Approval Request Transaction (SMART). Refer to OPSM 04-01 Subcontracting Work to Another Maintenance Provider.

The current OPSM revision is posted to the SWA Document Portal. Please review to ensure that you remain in compliance with this manual. As a reminder, the OPSM defines your requirements for compliance with the SWA Continuous Airworthiness Maintenance Program.
